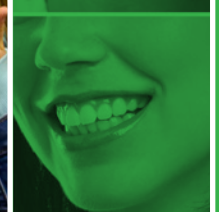
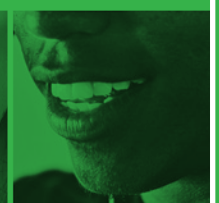
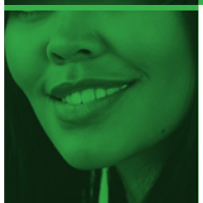

With a mission of promoting dental health for all Floridians, the FDA Foundation continues to grow and increase its impact on patients and public awareness of oral health.

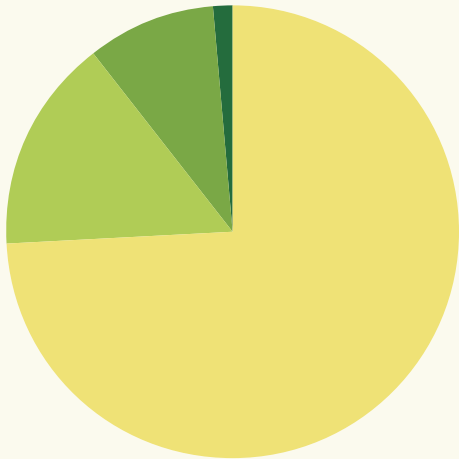
### **Program Efficiency:**

For every dollar donated, the FDA Foundation provided \$0.72 toward charitable programs and services.

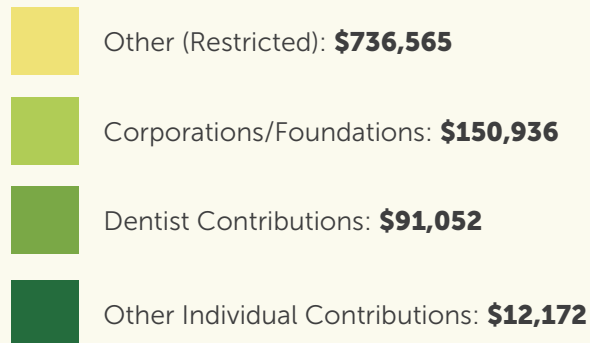

### 2024-2025 REVENUE



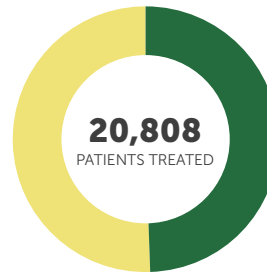
## PROJECT: DENTISTS CARE

Project: Dentists Care Inc. (PDC) is a statewide network of organizations that offer preventative and restorative dental care to those in greatest need. The FDA Foundation maintains a comprehensive list of dental access programs throughout the state in the Project: Dentists Care Resource Guide. These programs are eligible for annual grants from the FDA Foundation. For more than twelve years, PDC programs have provided treatment to 112,860 patients, resulting in more than \$70 million in donated dental care.

## DONATED DENTAL SERVICES

Donated Dental Services (DDS) is a program jointly funded by the FDA Foundation and Dental Lifeline Network • Florida. DDS helps individuals with disabilities or those who are elderly or medically fragile and cannot afford or otherwise access treatment for severe dental conditions. As a result of their age or disabilities, these patients cannot work and depend on government assistance for their health care. DDS alleviates the burden on patients, government programs and providers by using volunteer dentists and volunteer labs to treat patients with dental needs that far exceed patient averages for treatment time and cost. Since 1997, DDS has provided \$12 million in donated dental care to 2,275 patients.

## 2025 FLORIDA MISSION OF MERCY

The signature philanthropic program of the Florida Dental Association Foundation, *Florida Mission of Mercy (FLA-MOM)*, is the state's largest charitable dental clinic that provides care to any patient at no cost, with the goal of serving the underserved and uninsured in Florida – those who would otherwise go without care. Since its inception in 2014, *FLA-MOM* has provided \$19 million in donated services to 17,190 patients, with the help of 16,801 volunteers.

The 2025 *FLA-MOM* was held March 21-22 in Daytona Beach at Mainland High School. More than 2,000 volunteers provided \$1.92 million in donated care to 1,511 patients. The clinic provided oral health education, dental evaluations, oral cancer screenings, X-rays, extractions, fillings, root canals, cleanings and immediate dentures and partials. In addition, *FLA-MOM* provided a resource guide of local and regional community dental programs and clinics for patients to access routine care. Patients attending the clinic were encouraged to participate in the *FLA-MOM* Impact Study to gather information about their dental and general health, reasons for delaying dental care, and their use of local hospital emergency departments for their pain.
