

## Multivariate analyses – Jacksonville ED visit

## Age

Individuals aged 45 years and older were less likely to have an ER visit compared with the reference group of individuals 26-34 years old.

## Race and ethnicity

Hispanic individuals were less likely to have an ER visit compared with the reference group of non-Hispanic white.

#### Education

Individuals with some college education were less likely to have an ER visit compared with individuals with a high school or lower level of education.

## **Multivariate analyses – Jacksonville ED visit**

### Household Poverty Status

Individuals living in households with income below the poverty level were more likely to have an ER visit compared with those living at or above the federal poverty level.

#### Oral Health Status

Individuals who rated their oral health status as "fair" or "poor" were more likely to have an ER visit compared with those who rated their oral health status as good or better.

# Interestingly, these factors were NOT significant in those with an ED visit:

- Geographic location (urban or rural)
- Self-reported overall health status
- Insurance that covers dental costs (yes or no)
- Time since last dental visit
